The African American Leadership Forum (AALF) is a movement of more than 5,000 African American leaders, institutions, allies, and systems that come together to collaborate and champion solutions that improve the lives and experience of African Americans in Minnesota. For 15 years, AALF Twin Cities has harnessed the collective power of Black communities to solve complex social problems. Our goal is to build a just and healthy society that works equally well for everyone.

The African American Leadership Forum expresses its strong support for HF 55, which will establish the Office for Missing and Murdered Black Women and Girls, the first in the nation. AALF salutes the work of the Task Force which sufficiently argued the case for the State of Minnesota to allocate permanent staffing and resources to address the disproportionate violence against Black women and girls in Minnesota. With over 60,000 Black women and girls currently missing in the country, and Black women being three times more likely than white women to be murdered in Minnesota, the urgency to disrupt this dangerous cycle is evident.
