1, 2, and 4 to 16	H.F. 4068	Noor	Recodifies medical assistance (MA) sanctions and monetary recovery provisions and clarifies DHS authority to impose sanctions against individuals or entities that receive payments from MA or provide goods or services for which MA payment is made.
3	H.F. 4491	Schomacker	Establishes requirements for medical assistance prepayment review.

1 to 3	H.F. 3520	Gillman	Modifies intensive residential treatment services and intensive nonresidential rehabilitative mental health services requirements and clarifies that certain room and board services are eligible for behavioral health fund payment.

1 to 6 and 10	H.F. 3379	Schomacker	Repeals housing stabilization services and makes conforming changes.
7	H3423DE1, section 15	Schomacker	Requires the commissioner of human services to update rules to correct an incorrect federal citation.
8 and 9	H.F. 3378	Schomacker	Requires the commissioner of human services to release unredacted initial Optum reports and prohibits dissemination and publication of data.
