

Top 7 NO GO's when Planning Development Projects in BIPOC Neighborhoods!

- 1. State and Local Government ignoring or shutting out community from public comment and meaningful input on new developments.**
- 2. State and Local Government pushing projects which are not affordable to current and the most impacted neighborhood residents.**
- 3. State and Local Government supporting expensive housing projects which actively pushes out BIPOC communities; actively gentrifying BIPOC neighborhoods.**
- 4. State and Local Government supporting projects within BIPOC neighborhoods that reinforce environmental racism.**
- 5. Supporting projects that undermine safe, sustainable transportation options.**
- 6. Approving projects which violate Comprehensive Plans, intended to guide development. Plans that involved lots of community engagement, input, time, and money.**
- 7. State and Local Government pushing projects which are contrary to stated commitments to racial equity and do not address community benefits.**
