1.3 "Sec. 11. Minnesota Statutes 2012, section 245A.06, subdivision 1, is amended to read:

1.4 Subdivision 1. **Contents of correction orders and conditional licenses.** (a) If
1.5 the commissioner finds that the applicant or license holder has failed to comply with an
1.6 applicable law or rule and this failure does not imminently endanger the health, safety,
1.7 or rights of the persons served by the program, the commissioner may issue a correction
1.8 order and an order of conditional license to the applicant or license holder. When issuing a
1.9 conditional license, the commissioner shall consider the nature, chronicity, or severity of
1.10 the violation of law or rule and the effect of the violation on the health, safety, or rights of
1.11 persons served by the program. The correction order or conditional license must state:

- 1.12 (1) the conditions that constitute a violation of the law or rule;
- 1.13 (2) the specific law or rule violated;
- 1.14 (3) the time allowed to correct each violation; and
- 1.15 (4) if a license is made conditional, the length and terms of the conditional license.

1.16 (b) Nothing in this section prohibits the commissioner from proposing a sanction as
1.17 specified in section 245A.07, prior to issuing a correction order or conditional license.

1.18 (c) If a family child care provider has been issued a temporary immediate suspension
1.19 of the family child care license based on a violation of safe infant sleep requirements, the
1.20 commissioner may issue an order of conditional license that makes licensure contingent
1.21 on the provider no longer serving infants."
