- We all come from different countries where Spanish is the native language. We have been blessed to find opportunities to contribute our cross-cultural and multilingual expertise in the United States system, particularly in public education.
- We excel at our careers as educators because as native Spanish speakers with native fluency in English we are uniquely suited to fulfill the duties of our work: educating bilingual and bicultural students.
- We are here to share our stories and experiences as we seek your support in recognizing our legitimate academic background and our experiences as educators.
- As I mentioned earlier, I am a Tier 2 licensed teacher after completing a master's in education in Bilingual Programs with the University of MN.
- I am starting my 6th year as a kindergarten teacher in a Dual Spanish Immersion school, earning an award as a Fox 9 top teacher in 2019 and 9 years as a bilingual associate educator for Minneapolis Public Schools. I still don't have my Tier 3 license because I have been unable to pass the content exams. I work now for Edina Public Schools. We are opening a new Spanish immersion this fall, and they wanted expertised teachers to build this program. They wanted the best
- We hope that you are persuaded to see us, and other teachers like me as valuable assets in the education system. Parents seek programs like the one at Edina not only because of the benefits of being bilingual, but also because of the multicultural learning experience that an educator like me, can bring into the classroom
