1.3 "Sec. 21. [126C.122] CLASS SIZE REPORTING BY SCHOOL SITE.

1.4 Subdivision 1. School reporting by site. (a) A school district and a charter school must
1.5 annually report the district's class size ratios to the commissioner of education in the form
1.6 and manner specified by the commissioner.

1.7 (b) For kindergarten and elementary grades, the district or charter school must report
1.8 the average teacher to student ratio for each grade by site.

1.9 (c) For secondary grades, the district or charter school must report the teacher to student
1.10 ratio by site for each course that satisfies a graduation requirement in language arts, math,
1.11 science, and social studies under section 120B.024, subdivision 1.

1.12 Subd. 2. Legislative report. The department must annually submit a report beginning
1.13 December 1, 2024, to the chairs and ranking minority members of the legislative committees
1.14 with jurisdiction over kindergarten through grade 12 education detailing the statewide
1.15 teacher to student ratios by grade, by site, and by core subject area starting with the
1.16 2023-2024 school year. The department may include this information in its common course
1.17 catalog."

1.20 Page 18, after line 24, insert:

1.21 "(9) professional development for teachers on meeting the needs of English learners,
1.22 using assessment tools and data to monitor student progress, and reducing the use of

2.1 exclusionary discipline, and training for tutors and staff in extended day programs to enhance
2.2 staff's knowledge in content areas."

2.3 Page 26, delete section 34

2.4 Page 68, line 2, before "A" insert:

2.5 "Subdivision 1. **Training required.**"

2.6 Page 68, after line 12, insert:

2.7 "Subd. 2. **Training aid.** Beginning in fiscal year 2024, each school district, charter
2.8 school, and cooperative organization serving pupils is eligible for paraprofessional training
2.9 aid. Paraprofessional training aid equals \$196 times the number of paraprofessionals, Title
2.10 I aides, and other instructional support staff employed by the school district, charter school,
2.11 or cooperative organization during the previous school year. A school receiving aid under
2.12 this subdivision must reserve paraprofessional training aid and spend it only for the purposes
2.13 of subdivision 1."

2.14 Page 214, line 21, delete "\$100,000" and insert "\$175,000"
