Provides for a route turnback, by eliminating the statutory designation of Trunk Highway 274 from Wood Lake to south of Granite Falls.
3	R14	13	18-19	<u>10</u>	<u>10, 12</u>	Identical	<b>State-aid money needs.</b> Adds, in the calculation of “money needs” for county and city state-aid systems, road segments under the jurisdiction of a county or city but located outside of its borders.
4	R17	—	—	<u>7</u>	<u>6</u>	Senate only <i>Staff rec.: H4293A54 technical amendment</i>	<b>Air medal special plates.</b> Requires the commissioner of veterans affairs to design the emblem for a license plate for a veteran who is the recipient of the Air Medal, subject to the approval of DPS. <b>H4293A54 amendment:</b> makes conforming and technical changes.
5	R19	13	21	<u>7</u>	<u>7</u>	Technical difference <i>Staff rec.: Senate language</i>	<b>Veterans service group special plates.</b> Broadens eligibility for congressional chartered veteran service group special plates, to include members of Disabled American Veterans.
6	R20	13	22	<u>7</u>	<u>8</u>	Technical difference <i>Staff rec.: Senate language</i>	<b>Gold Star special plates.</b> Eliminates a \$100 fee to personalize Gold Star special license plates.

8	R22	—	—	<u>7</u>	<u>11</u>	Senate only <i>Proposed: SCH4293A59 amendment</i>	<b>Minnesota Missing and Murdered Indigenous Relatives special plates.</b> Establishes Minnesota Missing and Murdered Indigenous Relatives special license plates. <b>SCH4293A59 amendment (portion):</b> requires legislative report.
9	R24	13	24	<u>7</u>	<u>14</u>	Technical difference <i>Staff rec.: Senate language</i>	<b>Motor vehicle dealer; inspection.</b> Requires a vehicle dealer to make vehicle records available for inspection during identified inspection hours rather than business hours.
10	R36	<u>13</u>	<u>35</u>	—	—	House only	<b>Special registration plates.</b> Eliminates driver’s license possession requirements to obtain special series license plates (known as “whiskey” plates) after the original plates were impounded.

13	R70	<u>13</u>	<u>51</u>	11	2	Identical	<b>Transit operator accessibility training.</b> Directs the Metropolitan Council to ensure that Metro Transit and opt-out bus operators receive training on providing assistance in safely entering and exiting a transit bus.
