1.1 A bill for an act  
1.2 relating to human services; providing funding for a specialized mental health center  
1.3 and clinic; appropriating money.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. **APPROPRIATION.**

1.6 \$2,950,000 in fiscal year 2023 is appropriated from the general fund to the commissioner  
1.7 of human services for a grant to a mental health service provider that is a licensed community  
1.8 mental health center that specializes in services for African American children and families.  
1.9 The center must offer culturally specific, comprehensive, trauma-informed, practice- and  
1.10 evidence-based, person- and family-centered mental health and substance use disorder  
1.11 services; primary care screenings; and care coordination to all ages, regardless of ability to  
1.12 pay or place of residence. \$2,950,000 is added to the base for this purpose for fiscal years  
1.13 2024, 2025, 2026, and 2027.
