1.4 Subd. 3. **Data dissemination.** (a) Crime prevention block maps and names, home
1.5 addresses, and telephone numbers of volunteers who participate in community crime
1.6 prevention programs may be disseminated to volunteers participating in crime prevention
1.7 programs. The location of a National Night Out event is public data.

1.8 (b) The responsible authority of a government entity in consultation with the appropriate
1.9 chief law enforcement officer, emergency manager, or public health official, may make
1.10 security information accessible to any person, entity, or the public if the government entity
1.11 determines that the access will aid public health, promote public safety, or assist law
1.12 enforcement.

1.13 (c) Upon a joint request by both the chair and ranking minority member of a legislative
1.14 committee, the responsible authority of a government entity must allow the members of
1.15 that committee to inspect government data that is classified as nonpublic data because of
1.16 the data's status as either security information or trade secret information, provided that the
1.17 nonpublic data requested must be relevant to a government entity or program under the
1.18 committee's jurisdiction."
