Technical Clarification: Automatic Eligiblity for Foster Children	2	256B.055, subd. 2	Clarifies that all children placed in foster care or kinship assistance in Minnesota are automatically eligible for MA.
MA Asset Limit for Children Statute Reorganization	3	256B.056, subd. 3c	Reorganization of statute to include the statute for asset limits for children under age 21 in the same section of statute as all other asset limit provisions.
Remove Obsolete MA Annuities Language	4	256B.056, subd. 11	Updates a cross reference with the removal of language in 256B.0595, subd. 1.
Remove Obsolete MA Annuities Language	5	256B.0595, subd. 1	Strikes outdated language regarding the treatment of annuities in MA asset eligibility determinations.
Inclusivity within Telehealth	6	256B.0625, subd. 3b	Clarifies that the use of accessible video-based platforms used for telehealth are included in the definition of telehealth.
Updating the Managed Care Ombudsman Statute	7	[256B.6903]	Creates a new section to outline the roles and responsibilities of the managed care ombudsman office.
Updating the Managed Care Ombudsman Statute	8	256B.77	Updates a cross reference to the new managed care ombudsman statute.
Repeal Obsolete Trust Statute	9	501C.1206	Repeals statute preempted by federal law related to the revocability of certain trusts in accordance with a recent Minnesota Court of Appeals decision.
MA Asset Limit for Children Statute Reorganization; Updating the Managed Care Ombudsman Statute	10	Repealer	Repeals outdated language related to asset limits for children and the managed care ombudsman.
