Page 1, line 10, delete "\$255,000" and insert "\$213,000"

Page 1, line 17, delete "<u>fiscal year 2021 is appropriated from the remediation fund to</u>" and insert "<u>unexpended funds from the transfer made under Laws 2019, first special session, chapter 4, article 1, section 2, subdivision 10, paragraph (c), shall be expended by"</u>

Page 1, line 22, delete "This is a onetime appropriation and" and insert "The money made available under this paragraph"

Rep. Hansen moved that HF91 be amended by H0091A2, as amended, and a roll call was taken:
