

Subject Ethnic councils

Summary

This bill would establish an executive branch council to work for the economic, social, legal, and political equality of Minnesotans of Central and Eastern European heritage. The specific duties of the council can be found in section 1, subdivision 6 of H.F. 4364.

The Council on Central and Eastern European Affairs would operate in a similar manner to the state's three existing ethnic councils. The governor would appoint 11 public members, and the leaders of the two largest caucuses in the house and senate would each appoint one legislator.
