Effectiveness of efforts to address misclassification (1 of 4)

Misclassification-related intakes

Effectiveness of efforts to address misclassification (2 of 4)

Outcomes

12 wage claims (10 construction, two other)	25 wage claims (four construction, 21 other)
Three inform and educate (two construction, one other)	17 inform and educate (two construction, 19 other)

78 educate, self-help and/or referrals	77 educate, self-help and/or referrals

Effectiveness of efforts to address misclassification (4 of 4)

Outcomes

25 wage claims (four construction, 21 other)	64 wage claims
17 inform and educate (two construction, 19 other)	54 inform and educate
Eight investigations (two construction, six other)	22 investigations
77 educate, self-help and/or referrals	203 educate, self-help and/or referrals

Back wages to affected workers

- For wage claims where the worker reports misclassification, estimated \$46,403.21 collected in 64 wage claims.
- For inform and educate (I&E) where the worker reported misclassification, estimated \$20,057.91 collected from 54 cases.
- Investigations: Longer process resulting in only one investigation closing in 2025 relating to misclassification. A total of \$5,820 in back wages assessed and paid.
