

1.1 moves to amend H.F. No. 3643 as follows:

1.2 Delete everything after the enacting clause and insert:

1.3 "Section 1. **[85.0147] MELISSA AND MARK HORTMAN MEMORIAL STATE**
1.4 **PARK.**

1.5 Subdivision 1. **Establishment.** Melissa and Mark Hortman Memorial State Park is
1.6 established in the city of St. Paul in Ramsey County. The park consists only of the state
1.7 owned land within the boundaries provided under subdivision 2, that:

1.8 (1) is designated as green space by the commissioner of administration;

1.9 (2) contains commemorative works; or

1.10 (3) has been designated as the Tribal Flag Plaza.

1.11 Subd. 2. **Boundaries.** (a) Melissa and Mark Hortman Memorial State Park consists of
1.12 land bordered by:

1.13 (1) the point of intersection of 12th street and Cedar Street;

1.14 (2) then go westerly along 12th Street to Rice Street;

1.15 (3) then northerly along Rice Street to Aurora Avenue;

1.16 (4) then westerly along the land bordered by Aurora Avenue to the land bordering an
1.17 alley that abuts the western boundary of the state owned parking lot in the southwest corner
1.18 of Rice Street and University Avenue, with a minimum size of 20,700 square feet that is
1.19 planned to be converted to green space in the Capitol Mall Design Framework;

1.20 (5) then northerly along the land to University Avenue;

1.21 (6) then easterly along University Avenue to Rice Street;

1.22 (7) then northerly along Rice Street to Sherburne Avenue;

2.1 (8) then easterly along Sherburne Avenue to Cedar Street;

2.2 (9) then northerly along Cedar Street to Charles Avenue;

2.3 (10) then easterly along Charles Avenue to Capitol Heights;

2.4 (11) then southeasterly along Capitol Heights to Robert Street North;

2.5 (12) then southerly along Robert Street North to University Avenue;

2.6 (13) then southeasterly along Robert Street North to vacated Rev. Dr. Martin Luther

2.7 King Jr. Boulevard;

2.8 (14) then southwesterly along vacated Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard to

2.9 Cedar Street; and

2.10 (15) then southeasterly along Cedar Street to 12th Street to the point of beginning.

2.11 (b) Streets, roads, railways, and utilities owned by entities other than the state within
 2.12 the boundaries of the park identified under paragraph (a) are not included in the park and
 2.13 ownership remains with the entity.

2.14 Subd. 3. **Special state park designation.** Melissa and Mark Hortman Memorial State
 2.15 Park is designated as a special state park and not subject to the statutes or rules that apply
 2.16 to state parks designated under section 85.012.

2.17 Subd. 4. **Jurisdiction.** Establishment of the park under this section does not change
 2.18 authority or jurisdiction over the land within the park in accordance with chapters 15B and
 2.19 16B. This subdivision expires after the enactment of appropriations to fund the
 2.20 recommendations from the Melissa and Mark Hortman Memorial State Park Working
 2.21 Group.

2.22 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.

2.23 Sec. 2. **MELISSA AND MARK HORTMAN MEMORIAL STATE PARK WORKING**
 2.24 **GROUP.**

2.25 Subdivision 1. **Melissa and Mark Hortman Memorial State Park Working**
 2.26 **Group.** The Melissa and Mark Hortman Memorial State Park Working Group consists of
 2.27 the following members:

2.28 (1) the governor or the governor's designee;

2.29 (2) the commissioner of administration or the commissioner's designee;

2.30 (3) the commissioner of natural resources or the commissioner's designee;

3.1 (4) the chair of the Capitol Area Architectural and Planning Board or the chair's designee;

3.2 (5) a member representing the Minnesota Historical Society;

3.3 (6) the chairs and ranking minority members of the senate committees with primary
3.4 jurisdiction over the Department of Administration and Department of Natural Resources
3.5 or their designees;

3.6 (7) the co-chairs of the house of representatives committees with primary jurisdiction
3.7 over the Department of Administration and Department of Natural Resources or their
3.8 designees; and

3.9 (8) the mayor of the city of Saint Paul or the mayor's designee.

3.10 Subd. 2. **Recommendations.** The working group must make recommendations for the
3.11 creation of the Melissa and Mark Hortman Memorial State Park, including:

3.12 (1) identifying the roles and responsibilities of the commissioners of administration and
3.13 natural resources, the Minnesota Historical Society, and the Capitol Area Architectural and
3.14 Planning Board related to the administration of the park, including assigning the roles and
3.15 responsibilities for providing educational programming, interpretive services, planning
3.16 processes for physical changes, and public engagement activities within the park; and

3.17 (2) funding recommendations for establishing and maintaining the park and related
3.18 programming.

3.19 Subd. 3. **Chair.** The working group must elect a chair at its first meeting from among
3.20 the working group members.

3.21 Subd. 4. **Administrative support; meetings.** (a) The Legislative Coordinating
3.22 Commission must provide administrative support and convene the first meeting by July 15,
3.23 2026.

3.24 (b) The working group must meet at regular intervals as often as necessary to develop
3.25 the recommendations under subdivision 2.

3.26 Subd. 5. **Report.** By February 1, 2027, the working group must submit a written report
3.27 containing its recommendations to the chairs and ranking minority members of the house
3.28 of representatives and senate committees with primary jurisdiction over the Department of
3.29 Administration and the Department of Natural Resources. The working group expires March
3.30 15, 2027, or upon submission of the report required by this subdivision, whichever occurs
3.31 later.

3.32 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
