Since 1970, Headway has provided essential emotional health services to children, families, and individuals in the Twin Cities and surrounding areas. Our mission is to help you, your children, and your family back on the path toward emotionally healthy lives. We know what we're doing: with more than 40 years in operation, our 200-plus staff members in Richfield, Brooklyn Center, and Hopkins provide comprehensive mental health therapy and classes to more than 20,000 families each year.

Day Treatment - Filling the care gap

We are focused on rehabilitation that lasts a lifetime. Our goal is for students to leave our program emotionally strong, with high self-esteem and the resilience needed to cope with the normal social expectations of a mainstream school environment. Our program works best with 7th-12th graders who are inward-acting (self-injurious, depressive, self-isolating, truant, PTSD, etc.) rather than outward-acting (bullying, aggressive towards others, etc.). We work with students with mental or emotional health challenges that make it difficult for them to succeed in a mainstream educational setting.

There is also a demand for a middle ground for students who have been hospitalized or gone through a residential program but are not ready to return to a mainstream environment. We aim to fill that care gap and support students through their continued recovery and growth.

Where do our students come to us from?

In 2021, during the months of June and July Headway paid for students to be transported from the following communities to Day Treatment at Brooklyn Center:

Andover, Anoka, Blaine, Coon Rapids, Crystal, Maple Grove, Minneapolis, New Brighton, Robbinsdale, Saint Michael, Wayzata. Additionally, during this time period, Headway \paid transportation from the following communities to Day Treatment in Hopkins: Bloomington, Eden Prairie, Excelsior, Hopkins, Minneapolis, Minnetonka, New Hope,

With the ride service used Headway pays \$2.50/ mile for transportation.

Plymouth, Prior Lake, Richfield, St Louis Park, St Paul.
