1.4 Page 1, line 14, strike "birthday," and insert "and" and strike "birthday" and insert
1.5 "Birthday"

1.6 Page 1, line 15, before "On" insert "(b)"

1.7 Page 2, after line 4, insert:

1.8 "(c) On Washington's and Lincoln's Birthday, the one-hour patriotic observance may
1.9 include instruction to students on the following topics:

1.10 (1) George Washington's role in leading an anticolonial resistance to imperial power;

1.11 (2) George Washington's role in establishing a new republican form of government and
1.12 setting a precedent for the peaceful transfer of power;

1.13 (3) Abraham Lincoln's role in ending slavery through the Emancipation Proclamation
1.14 and passage of the 13th Amendment to the Constitution of the United States; and

1.15 (4) Abraham Lincoln's role as Commander in Chief in defeating the Confederacy and
1.16 reuniting the United States of America, including the role of Minnesota soldiers at
1.17 Gettysburg."
