We appreciate the committee's willingness to consider House Bill 2170, the "Buy Clean and Buy Fair Minnesota Act." Holcim is in support of these efforts in House Bill 2170 and is excited about the potential this act would bring to the state of Minnesota. Holcim remains committed to reducing the CO² levels it produces by working towards the goal of net zero emissions by 2050. Policy changes such as these provide incentives and directives for those in the building industry to accelerate their green growth and decarbonize their products.

We support this legislation and it's a critical first step to work towards a carbon neutral industry.
