The Minnesota Association of Community Mental Health Programs (MACMHP) is the state's leading association for Community Mental Health Programs, representing 33 community-based mental health providers and agencies across the state. Collectively, we serve over 200,000 Minnesota families, children and adults. Our mission is to serve all who come to us seeking mental and chemical health services, regardless of their insurance status, ability to pay or where they live. As Essential Community Providers, we serve primarily culturally diverse, low-income, uninsured and public healthcare program insured Minnesotans, who cannot access services elsewhere. We serve our clients with comprehensive, coordinated care and love.

Minnesota's CCBHCs are part of a new model of delivering integrated behavioral health care to Minnesotans. Originally built under a federal demonstration, the legislature passed legislation to transition this great model into a benefit under Medical Assistance.

MACMHP has been the main provider association representing the state's Community Behavioral Health Clinics (CCBHC). All eight current CCBHCs are members of our association, and we provide support across all the clinics looking to enter the model. As the state's CCBHC model is evolving under a Minnesota-specific care benefit, we are looking to update our statute to align with the model as it continues to evolve, maintaining critical components of the model in our statute and providing better pathways to serve clients with timely and the most appropriate care for them.
