Overview

This bill prohibits schools being built on or within one-quarter mile of a dump site or closed landfill, and requires existing schools built on or near such sites to provide notice to families and employees. The bill provides an exception to these requirements if testing requirements are met.

Summary

Section Description

School on landfill site; prohibition; notice. [School houses and sites; uses for school and nonschool purposes; closings]

Prohibits building a school on land that is within one-quarter mile of a dump site or closed landfill.

Requires a school within one-quarter mile of a dump site or closed landfill to annually provide written notice to parents of enrolled students and employees at the school. Specifies content of notice.

Allows school construction on a dump site and provides exception to notice requirement, if testing requirements are met, and the Pollution Control Agency makes certain findings about the test results.
