## **Bill Description**

This proposed bill amends existing restrictions regarding live cervid importation by creating additional exemptions for facilities accredited by the Association of Zoos and Aquariums, provided they meet specific criteria.

### Assumptions

Current records indicate there are 45 licensed exhibitors in Minnesota (link below from USDA Animal Care Public Search Tool) and they include small operations like reindeer farms. This includes 2133 class C exhibitors around the country. We assume this still requires one entity (source or recipient) to be American Zoo and Aquarium Association (AZA) accredited.

Additional live cervidae importations due to these exceptions will not result in substantial impacts to DNR oversight efforts.

### Expenditure and/or Revenue Formula

No fiscal impact.

### Long-Term Fiscal Considerations

This increases the risk of disease spread which could increase wild deer management costs. Should this occur we anticipate a need for increased funding for disease management efforts.
