- 1.11 recipients identified as possibly ineligible as a result of a periodic data match, and the number
- 1.12 of recipients whose eligibility was terminated as a result of a periodic data match. The report
- 1.13 must also specify, for recipients whose eligibility was terminated, how many cases were
- 1.14 closed due to failure to cooperate.
