Overview

This bill directs the commissioner of human services to develop a covered benefit under medical assistance (MA) for integrated health services and appropriates money for integrated health services.

This section directs the commissioner of human services to develop a covered benefit under MA for integrated health services.

Subd. 1. Develop covered benefit; integrated health services. Requires the commissioner of human services to develop a covered benefit under MA for integrated health services. Specifies standards and accreditation requirements integrated health services must meet. No later than October 1, 2026, requires the commissioner to submit to the legislature a report detailing eligibility, various requirements, and reimbursement rates for MA integrated health services.

Subd. 2. Establish demonstration project; integrated health services. Requires the commissioner to establish a demonstration project to develop and evaluate an integrated health services model of care. Sunsets the demonstration project on January 1, 2028. Specifies requirements for eligible sites for the demonstration project. Requires the commission to award at least \$300,000 per site to at least three eligible sites for the demonstration project and requires at least one of the sites to be located in rural Minnesota. Lists eligible uses of money.
