Summary

This bill modifies graduation requirements. It requires the 3.5 credits of social studies students complete as a graduation requirement to include one of the following in either 11th or 12th grade: a course in government and citizenship; or an advanced placement, international baccalaureate, or other rigorous course on government and citizenship. The bill also requires a district to offer a course for credit in government and citizenship to 11th or 12th grade students starting in the 2024-2025 school year.
