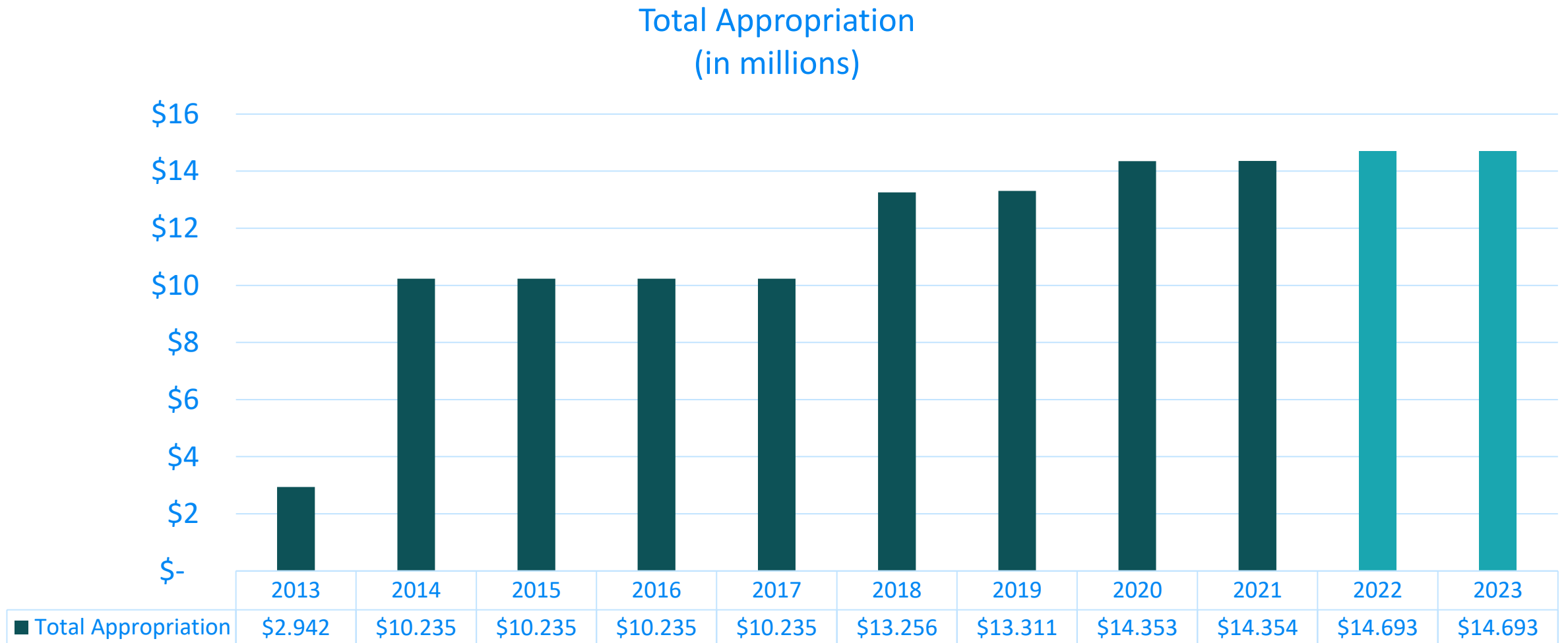

AGRI Appropriations



2020 – 2021 Biennium New/One-time Programs

Dairy Assistance, Investment, and Relief Initiative (DAIRI), FY 2020

- \$5 million, AGRI
- \$3 million, DEED

Ag Innovation Campus: \$5 million, FY 2021

Greater Mankato Growth, \$75k, FY 2020

Minnesota Turf Seed Council, \$75k, FY 2020 and FY 2021

2020 – 2021 Biennium Budget

Appropriation: \$14.35 million/year

Earmarks:

\$5 million: DAIRI in year 1, Soybean in year 2

\$2.5 million: Bioincentive Payments

\$1 million: County Fair Grants

\$400k: Farm to School Grants

\$300k: Urban Agriculture Grants

\$300k: Good Food Access Grants

\$75k: Minnesota Turf Seed Council

\$75k: Greater Mankato Growth (year 1 only)

AGRI Urban Agriculture Grant

Encourages urban youth agricultural education and urban agriculture community development within city limits of urban or peri-urban areas.

- FY 2021 Budget: \$280,500
- 2021 Request: \$1.87 million
- Award Range: \$1,000 - \$50,000

Farm Business Management Livestock Investment Grant

Reduces cost for beginning farmers to enroll for up to ten credits of FBM education per year, until the student earns 40 credits.

- FY 2021 Budget: \$484,000
- 2020: 525 scholarships
- 50% of costs

Helps livestock operations initiate and expand livestock production and processing; created through Minn. Stat. 17.118

- FY 2021 Budget: \$769,000
- 2021 Request: \$1.6 million
- Award Range: \$1,000 - \$25,000
- Match Requirement: 90%

Value-Added Grant Overview

Helps businesses, including meat processors, purchase equipment in order to create, upgrade, and modernize, and thereby increasing usage of Minnesota grown/raised products

- FY 2021 Budget: \$1 million
- 2021 Request: \$5.2 million
- Award Range: \$1,000 - \$150,000 or \$199,999
- Match Requirement: 75%

New Market Programs

Helps small- to medium-sized food businesses and value-added agriculture producers explore new markets and expand their market reach through Cost-Share and Minnesota Pavilions

- FY 2021 Budget: \$340,000
- E-Commerce Cost-Share: \$4,000 maximum
- Cost-Share for Wholesale Businesses: \$4,000 maximum
- Shift to e-commerce cost-share and cost-share for wholesale food businesses

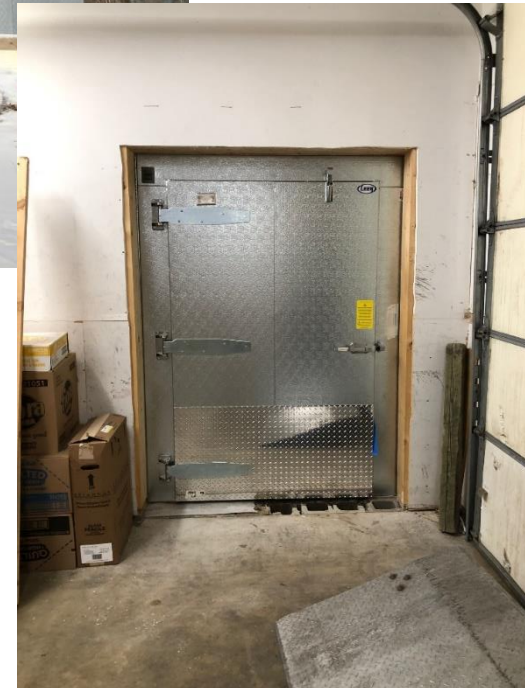


Good Food Access Program

Increases the availability of and access to affordable, nutritious, and culturally appropriate food (including produce) for underserved communities in low- and moderate-income areas.

- FY 2021 Budget: \$280,500
- 2021 Request: \$1.69 million
- Award Range: \$2,500 to \$50,00

Mark's Market, Kris Biessener



Reimburses school districts for purchasing Minnesota grown and raise foods used in school meal programs

- FY 2021 Budget: \$374,000
- Rapid Response Grants, First Bite Mini Grants, and Full Tray Grants
- 2021 Request: \$408,000
- Award Range: \$2,500 to \$35,000
