Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2024, section 340A.412, is amended by adding a subdivision

Subd. 12a. Transfers of wine. Notwithstanding the provisions of subdivision 12, the

holder of an off-sale intoxicating liquor license may transfer wine from one licensed premises
- 1.10

to another provided that:
- 1.11

(1) the license for the transferring and receiving premises are held by the same licensee;
- 1.12

(2) the licensee notifies the wholesaler from whom the wine was purchased and the

Division of Alcohol and Gambling Enforcement of the Division of Public Safety, in writing,

of the transfer; and

(3) only one transfer is made from a licensed premises in a three-month period.
