

1.1 moves to amend H.F. No. 3388 as follows:

1.2 Page 5, after line 23, insert:

1.3 "**Sec. 6. CONTINUATION OF STATE INNOVATION WAIVER.**

1.4 **Subdivision 1. Waiver application submission.** The commissioner of commerce must
1.5 apply to the Secretary of the United States Department of Health and Human Services under
1.6 United States Code, title 42, section 18052, for continuation of the state innovation waiver
1.7 previously granted to implement the Minnesota premium security plan under Minnesota
1.8 Statutes, section 62E.23, for benefit years beginning January 1, 2028, and in subsequent
1.9 benefit years, to maximize federal funding. The commissioner must submit the application
1.10 by December 31, 2026. The waiver application must clearly state that operation of the
1.11 Minnesota premium security plan after the 2027 benefit year is contingent on approval of
1.12 the waiver request. The commissioner of commerce shall reapply for the waiver as necessary
1.13 to continue the operation of the Minnesota premium security plan under Minnesota Statutes,
1.14 section 62E.23.

1.15 **Subd. 2. Notification.** The commissioner must notify the chairs and ranking minority
1.16 members of the legislative committees with jurisdiction over health and human services
1.17 and insurance, and the board of directors of the Minnesota Comprehensive Health
1.18 Association, regarding (1) the commissioner's intent to submit a waiver application, and
1.19 (2) federal action taken with respect to the waiver request."
