- Reservation access is not like the rest of the USA.
- Market Study in Red Lake in 2010.
- "Lack of Access" & "Equity " in higher ed. is key.
- "EDUCATIONAL CANYON" EXISTS. NOT A GAP.



TRANSFORMING COMMUNITIES

- To fill this canyon, we need everything! Red Lake Nation College is "A Great Place to Start!"
- To educate & provide entire support system.
- To instill pride in being Native.

<u>Vision</u>: Prepare students for bachelor's, master's and beyond, not just 2 years.

- HLC 10 Yr. Accreditation Process in 2010 2/24/21!
- 21st Century, \$11.4M Campus in 2015.
- All PhD and Master's Degree Instructors.
- Candidate Status now, <u>Full Accreditation on 2/24/21</u>
- Meet all MN OHE, Fin. Aid & Fed. Reporting req.
- Articulation Agreements w/ most MN 4 Yr. Schools.
- 160 Students in Fall 2019, 20+ grads/Yr./ 300 since 01'
- Liz Barrett, Dartmouth, Pre-Med student.
- Biggest TC Threats: Limited & reduced Federal funds and reduced grant funding.

RLNC PARTNERSHIP OPPORTUNITIES

- Currently, we have BSU, U of M Crookston, and FDLTCC, and WETCC Transfer agreements
- We need to make "EASE OF TRANSFER" For RLNC credits to all U of M system schools.

ALL MN STATE SCHOOLS (NO COST option)

- WHY?
- Close Gaps.
- U of M-Cr./Other States do it.

TRIBAL COLLEGE FUNDING INJUSTICE & INEQUITY

- MN State Constitution says..... "no people shall be discriminated against based on race"
- This is followed with <u>Non-Native Students</u> who attend TC's in MN, <u>TC's still get State funding for them!</u>
- However, <u>Natives who attend TC's in MN</u>, <u>TC's DO</u>
 <u>NOT GET ANY MN FUNDING!</u> <u>Great Injustice/Inequity!</u>
- WHAT IF YOUR MN SCHOOL RECEIVED NO STATE \$'S? \$100K in 20'
- TCU's greatly underfunded - Feds.

TRIBAL COLLEGE FUNDING INJUSTICE & INEQUITY

- <u>Tribal Colleges are OPEN TO PUBLIC BUT get no</u> <u>operational support from the State of MN</u> even though <u>ALL Natives are MN Residents</u>, <u>Dual</u> <u>Citizens</u>, <u>& pay all MN taxes</u>. Exc: Lic./On rez. Inc.
- Despite <u>Tribal Colleges providing the ONLY Higher</u> <u>Ed services on Indian reservations</u>.
- Tribal Colleges are the ONLY colleges serving this UNIQUE NICHE market in Higher Ed.
- Working with Governor's office & Higher Ed Comm.



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
