Bill Description

This bill directs OHE to require a judicial order or judicially ordered subpoena to disclose private educational data. All other proposed changes affect institutions of higher education, and do not change OHE's practices.

Assumptions

Data requests will be managed the same way they are now, so there is no major impact based on these proposed changes. The only anticipated change would be the documentation required to provide private educational data to a requestor.

Bill Description

This bill prohibits employees of Minnesota State institutions from allowing a federal immigration officer to enter their campus for any purpose unless the officer provides valid identification, a written statement of purpose, and a valid warrant issued by a state or federal judge or a federal magistrate judge that authorizes access to the campus. If a federal immigration officer meets these requirements, the officer's access must be limited to only the places, times, and individuals authorized under the judicial warrant.

If a federal immigration officer requests entrance to or is found present on a Minnesota State campus, the bill requires Minnesota State employees to notify the Chancellor or his designee.

The bill also provides that Minnesota State must not designate as directory information data on individuals that indicates or otherwise has the effect of identifying that an individual is not a citizen or national of the United States, including the individual's status as an international student.

Assumptions

Under the proposed language, Minnesota State would largely follow existing protocols. Costs for any updates to written procedure documents and training activities would be minimal.

Bill Description

An educational agency or institution may not designate as directory information data on individuals that indicates or otherwise has the effect of identifying that an individual is not a citizen or national of the United States, including the individual's status as an international student.

Except as required by state or federal law or as required to administer a state or federally supported educational program, an official, staff member, or other employee of a postsecondary institution must not allow a federal immigration officer to enter the institution's campus for any purpose unless the officer provides valid identification, a written statement of purpose, and a valid warrant issued by a state or federal judge or a federal magistrate judge that authorizes access to the campus.

If a federal immigration officer requests entrance to or is found present on the campus of a postsecondary institution, an official, staff member, or other employee of the postsecondary institution must notify: (1) the chief administrative official of the public postsecondary system, if the institution is a public postsecondary institution; or (2) the president of the postsecondary institution, if the institution is a private postsecondary institution. A chief administrative official or president may designate another school official, staff member, or employee to receive this notification on their behalf.

If a federal immigration officer meets the requirements of paragraph (a), the public postsecondary institution must limit the officer's access to only the places, times, and individuals authorized under the judicial warrant.
