1.16 Page 1, delete lines 17 to 19

1.17 Page 1, line 20, delete "(c)" and insert "(b)"

1.18 Page 1, line 21, delete "agency's" and insert "department's"

1.19 Page 2, delete subdivision 5

1.20 Renumber the subdivisions in sequence

1.21 With the recommendation that when so amended the bill be re-referred to the Committee
1.22 on Public Safety Finance and Policy.
