Chair Tabke moved H1597A2 amendment. THE MOTION PREVAILED. THE AMENDMENT WAS ADPOTED.

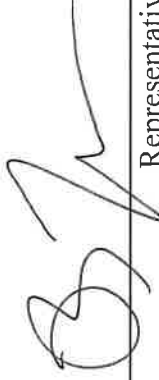
Representative Norris presented HF 1597 as amended.
