Graduation

- >550 family physicians graduates overall; approximately 75% still practice in Minnesota
- 50% of graduates (2021-2024) remained in Minnesota for primary care practice
- Since 2010, 82% of grads have remained in primary care practice for >10 years after graduation.

Accountability


- All Faculty are required to complete Time Studies (teaching audits) twice per year to ensure teaching, simulation training, feedback and curriculum development are occurring
- Resident experience surveys are required and benchmarked annually against national numbers
- Resident case numbers are tracked including number of pediatric, adult & geriatric, and births annually to ensure residents are entering the workforce capable and competent.
