- Subd. 6. **Eligible uses.** (a) A county, Tribal government, or local unit must use the aid under this section to provide public safety, including community violence prevention and intervention programs; community engagement; mental health crisis responses; victim services; training programs; first responder wellness; equipment related to fire, rescue, and emergency services; or to pay other personnel or equipment costs. A county, Tribal government, or local unit may use the aid under this section to purchase an armored or tactical vehicle or substantially similar vehicle, or for the costs of construction, reconstruction, remodeling, expansion, or improvement of a police station, including related facilities. For the purposes of this paragraph, "related facilities" includes access roads, lighting, sidewalks, and utility components on or adjacent to the property on which the police station is located that are necessary for safe access to and use of the building.
