1.7 Page 8, after line 3, insert:

1.8 "Sec. Minnesota Statutes 2020, section 340A.404, subdivision 1a, is amended to read:

1.9 Subd. 1a. ~~Cities~~ **Municipalities; auto racing facilities**. A ~~city~~ municipality may issue
1.10 an on-sale intoxicating liquor license to an auto racing facility located in the ~~city~~ municipality.
1.11 The license may authorize sales both to persons attending any and all events at the facility,
1.12 and sales in a restaurant, bar, or banquet facility located on the premises of the auto racing
1.13 facility. The license authorizes sales on all days of the week. The license may be issued for
1.14 a space that is not compact and contiguous, provided that the licensed premises may include
1.15 only the space within a defined area as described in the application for the license.

1.16 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.

1.17 Sec. Minnesota Statutes 2020, section 340A.404, subdivision 6, is amended to read:

1.18 Subd. 6. **Counties.** (a) A county board may issue an annual on-sale intoxicating liquor
1.19 license within the area of the county that is unorganized or unincorporated to a bowling
1.20 center, restaurant, club, ~~or~~ hotel, or resort as defined in section 157.15, with the approval
1.21 of the commissioner.

2.1 (b) A county board may also with the approval of the commissioner issue up to ten
2.2 seasonal on-sale licenses to restaurants and clubs for the sale of intoxicating liquor within
2.3 the area of the county that is unorganized or unincorporated. Notwithstanding section
2.4 340A.412, subdivision 8, a seasonal license is valid for a period specified by the board, not
2.5 to exceed nine months. Not more than one license may be issued for any one premises
2.6 during any consecutive 12-month period.

2.7 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment."
