

Bill Summary H.F. 2742 As Introduced

Summary

This bill extends the eligibility for free public school enrollment for students who were enrolled in grades 9 through 12 during the 2021-2022 or 2022-2023 school year. Currently, once a student turns 21, the student remains eligible until one of the following: (1) the next September 1; (2) the student completes graduation requirements; (3) the student withdraws from school and does not re-enroll within 21 calendar days; or (4) the end of the school year. The bill extends eligibility by one year; the student would remain eligible until one of these events occurs after the student turns 22.
