

Subject Postsecondary Enrollment Options

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Overview

This bill amends the Postsecondary Enrollment Options Act (Minn. Stat. § 124D.09), which governs dual enrollment programs.

There are two types of dual enrollment programs: postsecondary enrollment options (PSEO) and concurrent enrollment. Students participating in PSEO earn high school and college credit through enrollment in a college-level course taught at a postsecondary institution by college faculty. Students participating in concurrent enrollment earn high school and college credit through enrollment in a college credit-bearing course taught at the high school by either high school teachers or college faculty.

| 1 | Enrollment priority. [Postsecondary Enrollment Options Act] Eliminates limits on when postsecondary institutions may provide information to high school students and parents, advertise, recruit, or solicit high school students to enroll in the institution's courses. |
| 2 | Courses according to agreements. [Postsecondary Enrollment Options Act] Requires a high school and a postsecondary institution that enroll students in concurrent enrollment courses to report to the commissioner the participation rates of students in the courses. |
| 3 | Credits; grade point average weighting policy. [Postsecondary Enrollment Options Act] Requires a school board to adopt the same weighted grade point average policy for credits earned through PSEO as it does for credits earned through concurrent enrollment courses. |



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
