- » Transforms 150,000+ GSF to modernize campus for post-pandemic teaching and learning
- » Creates centralized student services hub to improve access, retention, and completion
- » Supports our vision of increasing enrollment and completion in high-demand programs that lead to careers providing a living wage
- » Right-sizes flexible learning spaces and upgrades building systems to meet code requirements
- » Eliminating \$4M in deferred maintenance and reduction in square footage

STUDENT IMPACT

Project Phasing

Phasing options exist for both projects

- » Saint Paul College: Reduce from \$34.9 million to \$24.0 million
- » Alexandria Community & Technical College: Reduce from \$35.5 million to \$24.0 million
