Overview

This bill requires publicly funded institutions that house felons and civilly committed persons to report undocumented persons to federal immigration authorities.

Summary

Section Description

1 Alien inmates; notice to United States immigration officers.

Para. (a). Requires the head of a state or local correctional facility to ask each person who is committed to the facility for a felony their nationality. If the inquiry identifies an undocumented person, the head of the facility must report the person to federal immigration authorities.

Para. (b). Requires the head of a state or local secure facility to ask certain civilly committed, mentally ill persons their nationality. If the inquiry identifies an undocumented person, the head of the facility must report the person to federal immigration authorities.

2 Inmate immigration status review.

Requires the head of a state or local correctional facility to ask each person currently housed in the facility for a felony their nationality. If a person committed to the facility is an undocumented person, the head of the facility must report the person to federal immigration authorities.
