1.4 Page 3, line 27, delete everything before the period

1.5 Page 4, line 5, before the comma, insert "by or with the participation of the covered
1.6 social media platform"

1.7 Page 4, line 9, after "covered" insert "social"

1.8 Page 5, line 13, before the period, insert "and shall not provide any default birthdate in
1.9 any form or query used to obtain that information" and after "create" insert "an account for
1.10 a user identified as a child pursuant to this provision"

1.11 Page 5, line 14, after "for" insert "a user to be treated as" and after "child" insert "pursuant
1.12 to subdivision 2,"

1.13 Page 5, line 18, after the comma, insert "and shall not be sold, transferred, or disclosed,"

1.14 Page 7, line 8, after "for" insert "a violation of this section. The court may award"

1.15 Page 7, line 33, after the period, insert "If the attorney general has reasonable cause to
1.16 believe that any covered social media platform has engaged in, is engaging in, or is about
1.17 to engage in, any knowing or reckless violation of this section, the attorney general may
1.18 investigate and pursue remedies consistent with section 325D.44."
