That is why we are focused on early brain development and giving every child the best start possible. To do that, we are promoting healthy childhood beginnings. Children's savings accounts (CSAs) are a wise state investment, especially when the CSA starts at birth as proposed in the MinneKIDS Act. Research shows that CSA programs have significant impacts on young children and parents:

- Improves early childhood social-emotional development in children, which is correlated with academic achievement later in life.^a
- Improves maternal mental health, lowering symptoms of depression in mothers whose children have a CSA.^a

These two findings alone illustrate the significant return-on-investment when investments are made in the earliest years of life.

HealthPartners urges the state legislature to support HF2864 / SF2850 to jumpstart 70,000 Minnesota babies each year with a children's savings account.
