Overview

This bill establishes a family supportive housing program administered by the Department of Human Services.

Summary

Section Description

1 Family supportive housing.

Creates § 256K.50. Establishes a family supportive housing program.

Subd. 1. Definitions. For purposes of the family supportive housing program, defines the terms "family," "family permanent supportive housing," and "resident."

Subd. 2. Specialized family support services. Lists specialized family support services that may be provided, including age-appropriate child-centric services for education and enrichment and stabilization services. Specifies that specialized family support services are nonmandatory, trauma-informed, and culturally appropriate services.

Subd. 3. Funding. Allows funds appropriated for this section to be expended on specialized family support services, technical assistance, and capacity building to meet the greatest need on a statewide basis. Requires the commissioner to provide outreach, technical assistance, and program development support to increase capacity to new and existing service providers.

2 Appropriations.

Appropriates \$5,000,000 in each fiscal year of the 2024-25 biennium from the general fund to the commissioner of human services for family supportive housing.
