Background

COPAL provides access to their Workers' Center to work with frontline Latino workers to recover lost wages, pursue employment discrimination cases, and connect to career training and placement services. We also work in the health sector as barriers don't just come in one form by connecting people to emergency housing support as well as access to basic need resources such as emergency food, mental health, childcare, and legal assistance.
