The board must obtain a criminal history background check on all first-time applicants in accordance with Minnesota Statutes, section 122A.181, subdivision 8. A short-call substitute teacher must comply with the code of ethics and the board may suspend or revoke a short-call substitute teacher license if the teacher violates the code of ethics.</u> <u>EFFECTIVE DATE. Dismissal of students in kindergarten through grade three. <u>(a) Notwithstanding subdivision 2, a pupil in kindergarten through grade 3 may only be dismissed in circumstances where the child poses a safety threat to the child or others.</u> <u>(b) For the purposes of this subdivision, a child poses a safety threat when the child willfully causes or attempts to cause serious and substantial physical harm to another person.</u> (see A107 Amendment)
