Modifies the procedure used to select the Hennepin County medical examiner by:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>changing the qualifications of members of the three-person Medical Examiner Board that accepts and reviews applications for the medical examiner position;</li><li>requiring applicants for the medical examiner position to be eligible for a Minnesota license to practice medicine, rather than eligible for appointment to the staff of Hennepin County Medical Center; and to be board-certified in forensic pathology, rather than certified or eligible for certification; and</li><li>requiring the Medical Examiner Board to provide the county board with a report on all applicants, rather than the seven highest ranked applicants.</li></ul> |
