1.2 Page 1, delete section 2

1.3 Page 2, delete sections 3 and 4

1.4 Page 3, delete section 5

1.5 Page 5, line 10, delete the new language

1.6 Page 5, line 11, delete the period and insert a semicolon

1.7 Page 5, after line 11, insert:

1.8 "(12) provide an orientation for recovery peers that includes an overview of the consumer
1.9 advocacy services provided by the Ombudsman for Mental Health and Developmental
1.10 Disabilities and other relevant advocacy services; and

1.11 (13) provide notice to peer recovery support services participants that includes the
1.12 following statement: "If you have a complaint about the provider or the person providing
1.13 your peer recovery support services, you may contact the Minnesota Alliance of Recovery
1.14 Community Organizations. You may also contact the Office of Ombudsman for Mental
1.15 Health and Developmental Disabilities." The statement must also include:

1.16 (i) the telephone number, website address, email address, and mailing address of the
1.17 Minnesota Alliance of Recovery Community Organizations and the Office of Ombudsman
1.18 for Mental Health and Developmental Disabilities;

1.19 (ii) the recovery community organization's name, address, email, telephone number, and
1.20 name or title of the person at the recovery community organization to whom problems or
1.21 complaints may be directed; and

1.22 (iii) a statement that the recovery community organization will not retaliate against a
1.23 peer recovery support services participant because of a complaint."

2.1 Page 5, after line 31, insert:

2.2 "Sec. **DIRECTION TO OMBUDSMAN FOR MENTAL HEALTH AND**
2.3 **DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES.**

2.4 By September 30, 2025, the ombudsman for mental health and developmental disabilities
2.5 must provide a report to the governor and the chairs and ranking minority members of the
2.6 legislative committees with jurisdiction over human services, containing summary
2.7 information on complaints received regarding peer recovery support services provided by
2.8 a recovery community organization as defined in Minnesota Statutes, section 254B.01, and
2.9 any recommendations to the legislature to improve the quality of peer recovery support
2.10 services, recovery peer worker misclassification, and peer recovery support services billing
2.11 codes and procedures."

2.13 Renumber the sections in sequence and correct the internal references

2.14 Amend the title accordingly
