My life felt like it was falling apart. I ended up moving back with my parents, starting over, and exploring other opportunities to bring my joy back.

For a long time, I worked random jobs to build up my resume, while secretly hoping to discover other job opportunities to bring my joy back. I couldn't find joy. Then Metro Deaf School opened a door: an opportunity for me to work as a paraprofessional. I was able to bring my joy back.

I want to go back to school as a teacher again to chase my dreams once again. This bill will help me with my student loans so I can become a successful teacher one day. It will help others chase their dreams to become teachers for our children, who are the future of this nation. Thank you to Rep. Klevorn for carrying this bill.
