# **Need for Increased Investment**


# Overview:

- Civil Legal Services (CLS) serves all 87 Counties and provides legal services to approximately **92,000 Minnesotans** every year
- CLS is forced to turn away 55% of all eligible clients seeking legal help
- CLS attorneys are the lowest paid attorneys in the public and non-profit sectors
- CLS has a turnover rate of 39% in 2021

#### **Current FY23 Funding:**

\$18,198,000

## 2021 CLS **Turn Away Rate**




55% of eligible people were unable to be served by CLS in 2021 due to a lack of resources.

\$22,502,000





CLS had a 39% turnover rate in 2021.

Without new investment in staff salaries, CLS turnover rates will continue to increase and the number of people who can receive help will decrease.


CLS helps families break the cycle of domestic violence
