Defines "live course."

Lists the requirements a proctor must meet.

4 Professional designation.

Defines "professional designation."

5 [45.301] On-demand continuing education; requirements.

Subd. 1. On-demand course requirements. Lists the technological and structural requirements for an on-demand course.

Subd. 2. Final examination. Requires that the final examination be encrypted online or a monitored paper examination.

6 Approval.

Makes changes to the requirements a person must meet to be approved by the commissioner as a course coordinator.

Section Description

7 Responsibilities.

Makes technical correction.

8 Revisor instruction.

Requires the revisor to change the term "self-study course" to "on-demand course" and change the term "classroom course" to "live course" where these terms are used in chapter 45.

9 Repealer.

Repeals section 45.25, subdivisions 2a and 14.
