

FAQ & Guidance	YES	Guidance on component-level reporting is inconsistent. It states reporting at the car radio level lacks clarity on PFAS use and requires identifying subcomponents (e.g., circuit board, wire coatings). However, radios are listed as options. Consumers benefit more from knowing PFAS is in the car radio, not subcomponents.	MPCA feedback required to clarify reporting expectations and consumer value.
FAQ & Guidance	YES	What is the maximum number of line items that can be uploaded in a single template?	Update guidance to clarify.
FAQ & Guidance	YES	Will a manufacturer be charged for each report submitted?	Update guidance to clarify.
FAQ & Guidance	YES	For individual brands under the same primary reporter, will multiple fees apply?	Update guidance to clarify.
FAQ & Guidance	YES	Federal preemption: EPA SNAP requires R1234yf—does reporting still apply?	Update guidance to clarify.
FAQ & Guidance	YES	OEMs will sell MY27 before the next reporting period (Feb 2027). What Model Year is required on July 1, 2026 if MY27 data is unavailable?	Update guidance to clarify.
FAQ & Guidance	YES	If the Primary User leaves the company, will system functionality allow updating the primary user?	Update guidance to clarify.
FAQ & Guidance	YES	Guidance on how to group similar products is unclear. The example provides paint lines that use the same PFAS and concentration. However, the image in the guidance shows each paint line reported individually rather than as a grouped product family, creating confusion.	Update the guidance to include an image of the paint lines reported individually and grouped for clarity.
FAQ & Guidance	YES	Guidance on how to group similar products and components is unclear. The example provided uses tabletop fans, which are described as eligible for grouping into product families. However, the image in the guidance shows each fan reported individually rather than as a grouped product family, creating confusion.	Update the guidance to include an image of the fans reported individually and grouped for clarity.
FAQ & Guidance	YES	Page 1: "contract production" should be "contracts production".	Correct the grammatical / spelling error in the displayed FAQ & Guidance.
FAQ & Guidance	YES	Page 1: Wording is unclear: "The importer of first Domestic distributor if the producer/ brand owner has no U.S. Presence."	Update to provide clarity. "The importer or the first domestic distributor if the producer or brand owner has no U.S. presence."
FAQ & Guidance	YES	Page 1: Remove space in "1 st".	Correct the grammatical / spelling error in the displayed FAQ & Guidance.
FAQ & Guidance	YES	Page 1: "Manufactures will only be charged..." misspelling of "Manufacturers".	Correct the grammatical / spelling error in the displayed FAQ & Guidance.
FAQ & Guidance	YES	Page 2: "...received an exempted from the sale prohibition." should be "received an exemption from the sales prohibition".	Correct the grammatical / spelling error in the displayed FAQ & Guidance.
FAQ & Guidance	YES	Page 2: "...received an exempted from the sale prohibition." should be "received an exemption from the sales prohibition".	Correct the grammatical / spelling error in the displayed FAQ & Guidance.
FAQ & Guidance	YES	Page 10: - "Aftermarket parts produced by the same manufacturer may require to be reported." Should read "Aftermarket parts produced by the same manufacturer may be required to be reported."	Correct the grammatical / spelling error in the displayed FAQ & Guidance.
FAQ & Guidance	YES	Page 11: "request trade secrete status" misspelling of "secret"	Correct the grammatical / spelling error in the displayed FAQ & Guidance.
FAQ & Guidance	YES	Page 12: "If you are experiences technical issues " should be "If you are experiencing technical issues".	Correct the grammatical / spelling error in the displayed FAQ & Guidance.
FAQ & Guidance	YES	Page 12: "company's following the instructions" should be "companies following the instruction".	Correct the grammatical / spelling error in the displayed FAQ & Guidance.
FAQ & Guidance	YES	Page 12: "'Functional groups(s)" should be "Functional group(s)"	Correct the grammatical / spelling error in the displayed FAQ & Guidance.

PRISM System	YES	If the reporter has the search function open (for component or PFAS name), the system does not time out. When attempting to save the file, an error occurs and data is not saved. Implement a timeout or alert mechanism to notify reporters that data will not be saved if the search function remains open. Screenshot of error in the opportunity for improvement column.	
PRISM System	YES	Selecting PFAS name in the system, the PFAS name overlaps the CASRN. Screenshot for reference.	
PRISM System	YES	System does not allow multiple report deletions; user must delete one at a time.	Update system to enable multi-select deletion of reports.
PRISM System	YES	Save button is greyed out when a template is uploaded. Only the save and exit button is highlighted. It is not clear that data that is uploaded via template is automatically saved.	Update the system to enable the save button so users can save data that is uploaded, even if the system automatically saves it once uploaded.
PRISM System	YES	System does not accept data when typed in a different format even if it matches the value (e.g. "hts" vs. "HTS", "casrn" vs. "CASRN").	Update the system to accept the data in any case and automatically update to the PRISM system format.
PRISM USER Guides	YES	Grammatical error on the PRISM User Guide screen. The text currently reads: "The PFAS Reporting Information System for Manufacturers (PRISM) Search Guide is for data consumers." It should be updated to: "The PFAS Reporting Information System for Manufacturers (PRISM) Search Guide is data for consumers."	Correct the grammatical error in the displayed User Guide text.
Report Template	YES	Dropdown list for component selection is cumbersome (29K+ items). Incorrect MN nomenclature prevents accurate search (headlamp vs. headlight).	Replace dropdown with free-text entry.
Report Template	YES	Dropdown list excludes many automotive components, making search impractical at lowest level. Example: Component = "Duct", 1K+ potential components, none of which are applicable to the automotive sector.	Replace dropdown with free-text entry.
Report Template	YES	Errors column displays "VALUE" instead of YES/NO, causing confusion.	Remove macros from the file as it is not functioning.
Report Template	YES	Errors are not visually highlighted in template, reducing visibility for correction.	Highlight errors in the template for quick identification.
Report Template	YES	No dropdown search for the PFAS name column in the report template. Also, if CASRN is entered, it generates an error in the template. PFAS dropdown is search limited to name only; CASRN lookup not supported in template.	Enable search by PFAS name or CASRN for accurate identification.
Report Template	YES	PRISM system was updated to include fluoropolymers, but the template did not align with the additional substances (e.g., CAS 25190-89-0 appears in the system but not in the template).	Ensure the template and system are synchronized so all PFAS substances listed in PRISM are reflected in the reporting template.
Report Template	YES	PRISM system includes components that are not available in the template (e.g. gasket).	Ensure the template and system are synchronized so all components listed in PRISM are reflected in the reporting template.
Report Template	YES	Report template flagged errors and failed file upload, but the same data entered directly into the system was validated successfully.	Macros error preventing file upload success.
Report Template	YES	Report template flagged errors in each of the data fields that contain a dropdown validation value, even when the data was selected from the dropdown list function.	
Report Template	YES	Vehicle manufacturers assemble vehicles but do not manufacture components. OEMs lack Tier-N data for PFAS function; only material classification is available. Even Tier 1 suppliers may not have this data.	Update the function listing to allow reporting of PFAS function as "Unknown / Not Attainable" for complex articles with globally intricate supply chains.
Report Template	YES	Excel file lags when moving between cells.	Optimize template for faster processing.

Report Template	YES	Column "HAS ERRORS" displayed "#NAME" and did not highlight errors. Required manual unhide of columns O-AA to identify issues. Duplicate entry of component/function was needed to clear errors.	Fix error-checking logic; ensure columns and error flags function correctly without manual intervention.
Report Template	YES	Template does not flag duplicate entries, but system flags duplicates during manual entry.	Align template validation with system logic for duplicate detection.
Report Template	YES	If a new substance or component is added to PRISM, there is no mechanism to notify manufacturers that changes have been made or that a new report template must be downloaded.	Implement a notification feature to alert reporters when substances or components are added or updated. Options include a pop-up message upon login or an accessible revision log documenting all template updates.
Report Template	YES	When a reporter manually enters data and then clicks <b>Upload Template</b> , closing the pop-up without uploading a file, the system deletes all unsaved manually entered data.	Ensure manually entered data is retained when the upload function is opened but not used.
Reporting Guide	YES	Instructions should clarify that the template form is linked when clicking "Upload."	Update Reporting Guide to clearly explain template linkage during upload.
