

1.1 moves to amend H.F. No. 1132, the first engrossment, as follows:

1.2 Delete everything after the enacting clause and insert:

1.3 "Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 16B.325, is amended by adding a subdivision
1.4 to read:

1.5 Subd. 5. Sustainable building guidelines certification. (a) The recipient of an
1.6 appropriation from the bond proceeds fund or general fund which is subject to section
1.7 16A.642 must complete a sustainable building guidelines certification form in accordance
1.8 with this section to determine if the guidelines apply to the project. If the guidelines are
1.9 determined to be applicable, the project owner and its design consultants must meet the
1.10 guidelines on the project and cooperate with the Center for Sustainable Building Research
1.11 at the University of Minnesota to ensure compliance with the guidelines. The commissioner
1.12 of administration shall prescribe the form and manner of the sustainable building guidelines
1.13 certification form.

1.14 (b) A state agency must not execute a grant agreement for a capital project funded with
1.15 an appropriation from the bond proceeds fund or the general fund which is subject to section
1.16 16A.642 until the granting agency has received a sustainable building guidelines certification
1.17 form signed by the appropriation recipient from the commissioner of administration indicating
1.18 whether the project is subject to the guidelines. A granting agency may refrain from
1.19 disbursing grant proceeds if the grantee has not complied with the guidelines.

1.20 (c) A grantee that fails to comply with this subdivision must repay the outstanding
1.21 balance of the grant to the commissioner of management and budget within 60 days of the
1.22 date from which the granting agency notifies the grantee that repayment is required. Failure
1.23 to repay the outstanding balance of the grant authorizes the granting agency to take any
1.24 actions authorized by law to enforce the requirements under this paragraph.

2.1 Sec. 2. **APPROPRIATION; CENTER FOR SUSTAINABLE BUILDING**
2.2 **RESEARCH.**

2.3 \$304,000 in fiscal year 2024 is appropriated from the general fund to the commissioner
2.4 of administration to fund outreach and education efforts by the Center for Sustainable
2.5 Building Research at the University of Minnesota to inform local governments and other
2.6 grantees of state funds for capital projects meeting applicability under Minnesota Statutes,
2.7 section 16B.325, subdivision 3, about planning for and compliance with sustainable building
2.8 design guidelines. This appropriation is available until June 30, 2025."
