Summary

Recovery community organizations are independent organizations led and governed by representatives of local communities of recovery, that do the following:

- mobilize resources to increase prevalence and quality of long-term recovery from substance use disorder;
- provide peer-based recovery support activities and training of recovery peers;
- provide mentorship, ongoing support, and other resources to individuals with substance use disorder;
- promote a recovery-focused orientation in community education and outreach programming; and
- organize recovery-focused policy advocacy activities.

This bill appropriates \$2,000,000 in fiscal years 2022 and 2023 from the general fund to the commissioner of human services for grants to recovery community organizations to provide for costs and community-based peer recovery support services that are not otherwise eligible for reimbursement under section 254B.05.
